

Activity Report
For the month of April 05- June 05

1. For the last 3 months, April-June 2005 we had to make numerous home visits with a view to sensitize the parents to make their daughters admitted to the next higher classes early. Many parents had to be persuaded that their daughters studying in class VI onward should not get married. We visited schools also to make the school authorities understand that the admission fees should not be so high as the village parents cannot afford to pay that. Some parents wanted us to pay the admission fees for their daughters.
2. We organized community level meetings to sensitize the parents and the community with a view to making the whole community conducive to the environment.
3. We organized tutors meet 3 times in the last 3 months. Our motto was to motivate them and to make them abreast with the problems of the students and find ways of how more efficiently teachings could be imparted to the students.
4. Tuition fees have been paid to all 57 tutors for the month of May and June, 2005. Monthly tests have been taken for the month of June.
5. The core team consisting of 58 girls students on an average have been imparted training for 3 days(for the month of May, June and July).
6. Issues discussed in the meetings were:
 - * Problems the students face for admission to the classes.
 - * Problems the students (who failed in the classes) face, their parents attitude toward their daughters and the role of the core team.
 - * Problems the elder students face in the family and community and the role of the core team.
