ACTIVITY REPORT

JULY 2005- SEPTEMBER 2005

- 64 tutors have been given tuition fees for the month of July and August 2005. Tuition fees for the month of September will be given to October 2005.
- 251 students of class V, IX, X have been distributed uniform.
- Home Visits of 1000 girl students have been undertaken regularly to ascertain whether she is regularly going to school or to the tutors.
- 4 tutor-parent meets were held during this period. Problems of the students and role of parents were discussed.
- Mrs. Rithu Sarawagi- Expert visited NISHTHA for 4 days and trained the tutors and staff. She also visited the village and inspected the functioning of the coaching classes.
- Regular weekend classes were taking for 210 Grade-D students. A total of 11 weekend classes took place.
- The grade sheet revealed the improvement in the results of some students of Grade-D.
- Admission fees have been paid for 46 very poor students whose parents could not afford to pay the admission fees.
- Full book grants have been given to 11 girl students as these students were very poor and unable to purchase books.
- 800 more students were given book grant of Rs.125/- each as part payment. The remaining amount has been paid by the parents.
- Book grants need not be given to 189 students as they are primary students.
- 1000 students have been supplied with note books.
- Johura Khatun, daughter of Rafikul Islam, village Balakhali and a student of class IX came to NISHTHA secretly as her mother arranged her marriage. She was not willing to marry as she wanted to continue her studies. After we persuade the local leaders to intervene and we lodged a complain to the local police station and her mother postponed the marriage and allowed her to go to school regularly.

- Another of our students Alpona Mondal, father Sufal Mondal of class VI died on September 1, 2005. The villagers and her parents requested us to take Shibani Mondal her younger sister, a student of class III, has been included in this programme. Kindly approve Sibani's inclusion and regularized her. They are very poor.
- Monthly test gave been taken in July, August and September and grade sheet for those months have already been sent to you.
- 3 tutors meet have been organized.
