#### **Brief Description of the Project**

The prime object of our organization is to provide education for the deprived Urban Children. Three Schools have been set up for this purpose at Santragachi area in Howrah district, Bhangar in South 24 Parganas and at Panditiya Slum in South Kolkata. These schools have started functioning from February 2006 with help from Child Vikaas International in U.S.A. (monitored by CINI ASHA Kolkata). The process was initiated in February 2006 and the classes started from 6<sup>th</sup> March 2006.
